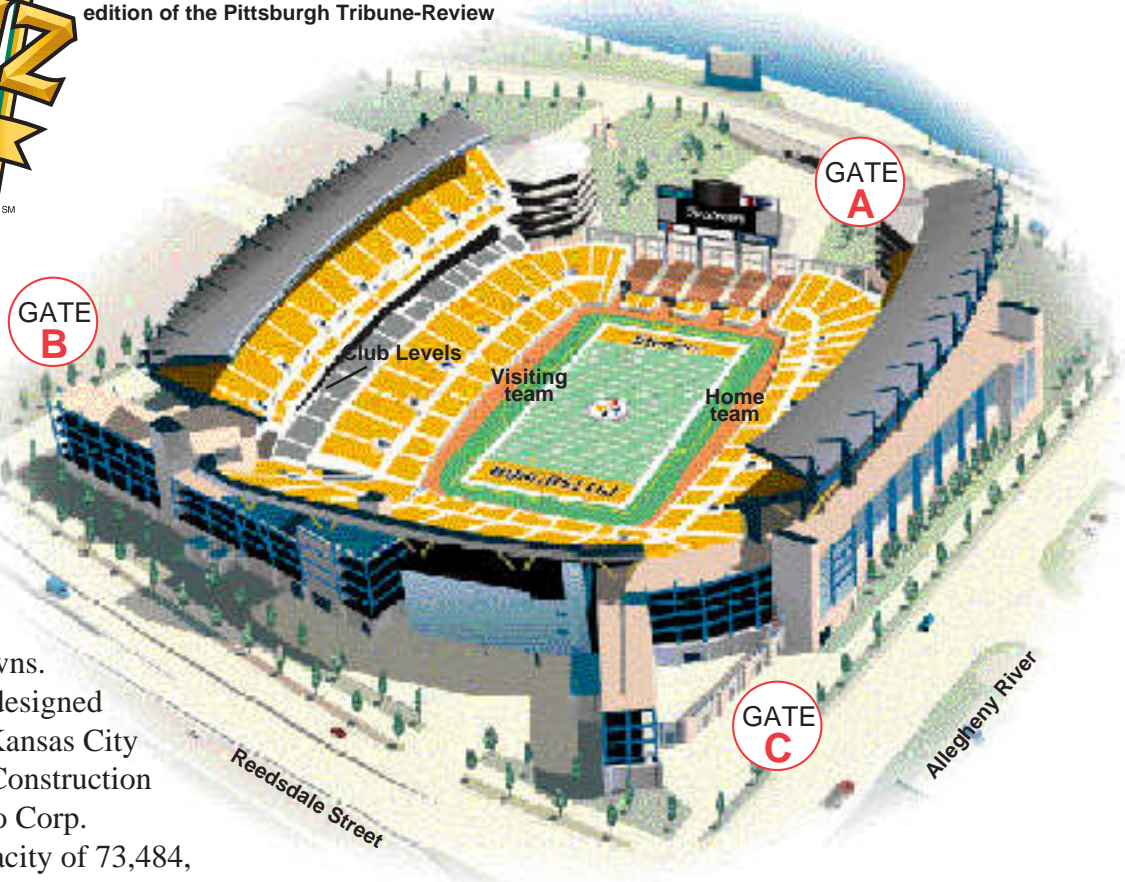

The new home of the Pittsburgh Steelers and the Pitt Panthers, Heinz Field plays host to its first regular season game Sept. 16, when the Steelers play the Cleveland Browns. The structure was designed by HOK Sport of Kansas City and built by Hunt Construction Group and Mascaro Corp. With a seating capacity of 73,484, the stadium is a two-deck structure with two floors of luxury boxes.



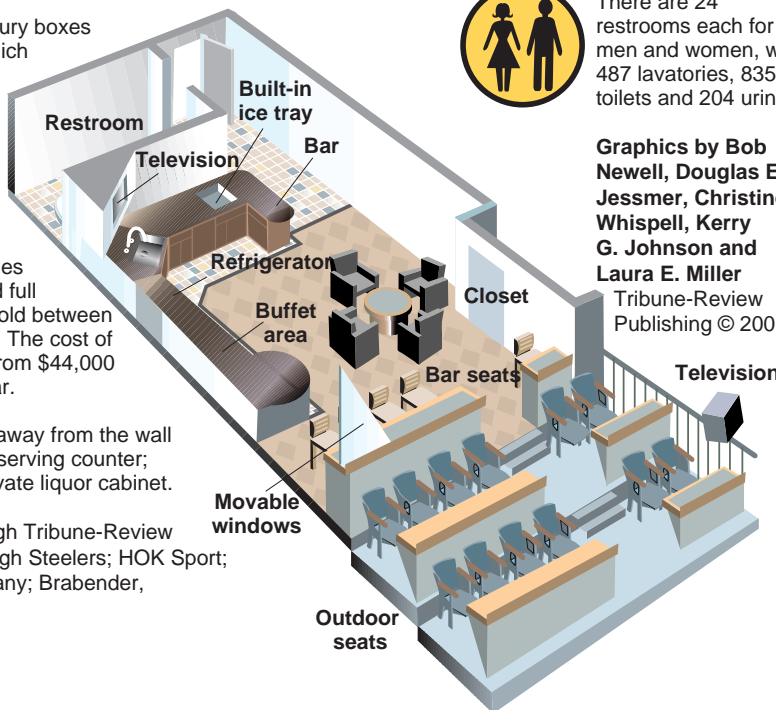
## Inside the luxury suites

There are 130 luxury boxes at Heinz Field, which have 1,544 seats, totaling more than 38,000 square feet. They are located above the Club Level.

There are two styles of suites, mini and full size. The suites hold between 14 and 24 guests. The cost of the units ranges from \$44,000 to \$120,000 a year.

Catering is a call away from the wall phone above the serving counter; there also is a private liquor cabinet.

There are 24 restrooms each for men and women, with 487 lavatories, 835 toilets and 204 urinals.



At least one first-aid station is on each level of the stadium.

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Don't feel like a long walk? Check out the elevators and escalators. There are seven passenger elevators and four escalators, as well as four pedestrian ramps and five staircases.



Two lounges on the club level, totaling about 45,000 square feet, are three-story atriums with large bars, beverage kiosks, specialty food stands and a video wall. The lounges also convert into banquet space.



There are 47 concession stands and seven novelty stands. A team store is planned for the future.
